- Our stores are tailored to their environment
- The majority of our stores are located in town centres, district centres or at the edge of centres
- Our store formats include:
 - Smaller stores: 15,000-30,000 sq ft
 - Superstores: 42,000 sq ft
 - Supercentres: 85,000 sq ft
 - ASDA Living: 30,000 sq ft

Local sourcing at its best

Taking the lead in making locally sourced and produced goods available in every one of our stores.

- 400 local producers supplying ASDA with over 4,000 local products
- 90% of the meat and fresh produce we sell comes from British farmers
- National network of local supplier 'hubs'
- 61% of ASDA local suppliers employ less than 20 people
- Customers and colleagues suggest local products in store



We hate waste of any kind

We are committed to changing our business for the benefit of the environment. Since 2005 we've cut energy use by 11%. We will also:

- Send zero waste to landfill by 2010
- Cut our own brand food packaging weight by 25% within a year
- Reduce new store energy requirements by 30% by 2010*
- Reduce existing store and distribution centre energy requirements by 20% by 2012*

Store energy performance

Our new stores are being monitored for their energy saving per square foot against typical **ASDA** stores built in 2005.

Store	Size (gross sq ft)	Energy Saving	Opened
Girvan	27,941	17%	August 2007
Seaham	42,118	27.1%	September 2007
Ardrossan	47,562	15.2%	September 2007
Shaw	66,316	28.8%	August 2007

We are also aiming to reduce the energy consumption across our estate by 20% by 2012. The table below shows how some of our 2005-6 stores are progressing.
